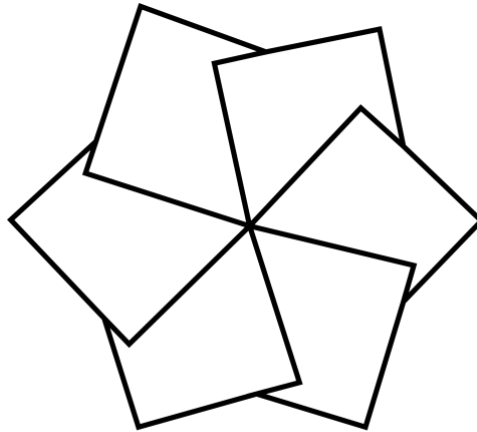
Friday 14th June (11am – 1pm)

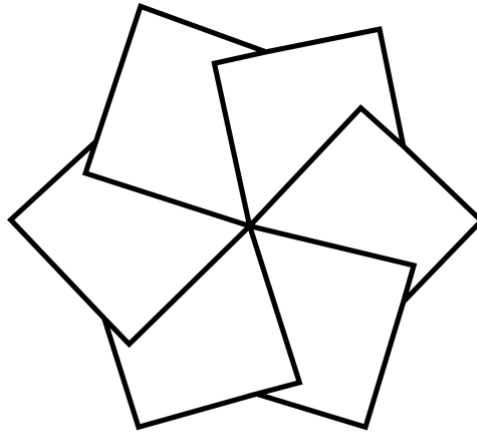
